Re: Appeal again denial of information by CPIO, IFCI under RTI Act

I have to submit that the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), IFCI has provided me a part of the information vide his letter No. IFCI/RTI/1029/2022-220510002 dated 10-05-2022 in reply to my RTI request dated 11-04-2022. (Copies are available with IFCI, hence not enclosed as a Green campaign). As the CPIO, IFCI has not provided complete and correct information which tantamount to denial of information, I hereby prefer my first appeal under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

2. In points (a) and (b) of para 1 of my RTI application, I had requested the CPIO to provide me the amount of pay/emoluments taken into consideration for fixation of pension of my late husband with reference to the revised pay scales applicable to him with effect from 1.11.2002 and the amount of pension fixed for my husband with reference to the revised pay scales effective from 1.11.2002. Against this, the CPIO has forwarded me a Statement showing the calculation of his pension as per the pay scales applicable for the period 1.11.1997 to 31.10.2002, **which is not correct information**, as per my request.

3. You are, therefore, requested to kindly pass orders directing the CPIO to provide me correct information in regard to –

(a) The amount of pay/emoluments taken into consideration for fixation of pension of my late husband [redacted] per the pay scales effective from 1.11.2002 according to which he received revised salary and allowances as he was in service as on that day.

(b) Disclose the amount of pension refixed based on the revised pay scales w.e.f. 1.11.2002 and provide me a certified copy of the Statement showing the calculation of his pension as per the pay scales effective from 1.11.2002.
