Subject : First Appeal under RTI Act 2005 against denial of information by CPIO,IFCI

The CPIO, IFCI has provided me some information vide letter No.IFCI/RTI/978/2021-211220010 dated 20-12-2021 in response to my RTI application dated 23-11-2021 (since both communications are available in IFCI's records, copies of the same not enclosed as green campaign). As the information is incomplete and incorrect which tantamounts to denial of information, I hereby submit my first appeal and request you to kindly direct the CPIO to provide me the complete and correct information. The shortcomings and deficiencies in the information provided by CPIO, IFCI and my appeal are as under:-

- (i) ANNEXURE-B TO IFCI's above-referred letter - Date of retirement of my husband [redacted] has wrongly been shown as 30.04.2007 whereas he had actually retired on **16-01-2001**. Similarly the average pay for the ten months for the period July, 2006 to April, 2007 has **wrongly been provided to me.**

CPIO, IFCI may kindly be advised to provide me the correct information and provide a fresh Annexure.

- (ii) ANNEXURE-C TO IFCI's above-referred letter - This Annexure is a letter dated 16-4-2001 and not letter dated 17/7/2001 as mentioned at Sl.No.2.5 of CPIO's letter under reference. Enclosure showing the "basis of calculation of pension and commutation amount" mentioned in the last sentence of para 1 of the letter dated 16-4-2001 not received along with the CPIO's letter dated 20-12-2021, referred to above.

Kindly advise the CPIO, IFCI to provide a certified copy of the Calculation Sheet showing calculation of pension and commutation amount in respect of my husband [redacted] as mentioned in letter dated 16-4-2001 and also provide copy of IFCI's letter dated 17/7/2001.

- (iii) ANNEXURE-D TO IFCI's above-referred letter - The calculations given in the Table are not clearly legible and the Table is without covering letter. The same also does not disclose the components of basic pay and other allowances taken into account for fixation of pension of my husband, [redacted]. Moreover, for a homemaking lady, not with high academic qualifications, it is not possible to comprehend a large number of sets of figures.

Therefore, kindly advise the CPIO, IFCI to provide me briefly and specifically -

- (a) Total amount of Basic salary and other allowances taken into account for fixation of pension of my late husband.
- (b) Pay Scale period during which the last pay drawn by my husband fell.
