Terms and Conditions for Empanelment of Chartered Engineer

1. BACKGROUND

IFCI Limited is a Government of India (GoI) Undertaking, a company incorporated under Companies Act, 1956 and a Public Financial Institution (PFI) under Section 2, sub-section (72), clause (iv) of the Companies Act, 2013 and having its registered office at—IFCI Tower, 61, Nehru Place, New Delhi -110 019 (here in after referred as IFCI).

IFCI has been appointed as Project Management Agency (PMA) / Service Provider by various Ministries for managing various Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Schemes which inter alia includes assessment of Investment done by the applicant companies in a financial year to qualify under the scheme.

2. PURPOSE

IFCI Limited proposes to form empanelment of competent Chartered Engineer for carrying out assessment of following classes of asset:

- (i) Civil Works;
- (ii) Plant & Machinery;

3. MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The minimum eligibility criteria are provided at **Annexure-B**.

4. APPLICATION SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The application shall be submitted in accordance with the following guidelines:

- (i) An applicant eligible for both the asset classes only are required to make application.
- (ii) One Applicant shall submit only a single application and cannot be a constituent to any other application.
- (iii) Application shall be submitted in the format prescribed at **Annexure-A.**
- (iv) The application shall be unconditional, else, it would be liable for rejection.
- (v) The applicant shall make a payment of non-refundable application fee amounting to INR 5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) in the following account:

5. EMPANELMENT PERIOD

The Chartered Engineer shall be empaneled for a period of 3 years. However, a review exercise may be done periodically based on the performance. IFCI reserves the right to delist the name of the consultant at any stage, if found unsatisfactory or does not comply with

IFCI's requirement or due to any other internal reasons. IFCI's decision will be final in this regard.

6. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work would include independent assessment of investment incurred by a company for a particular period. Investment would include the following component:

- i. Plant & Machinery
- ii. Civil Works

The Chartered Engineer will be required to visit the factory premises of the applicant companies and give a certificate on the investment made by the company in the format prescribed by IFCI Limited.

Broad scope of work:

- Background information of the asset being assessed;
- Assessment of approvals for the approved products under respective scheme;
- Disclosure of Chartered Engineer interest/conflict, if any;
- Date of appointment, Chartered Engineer certificate date and date of report;
- Sources of information/documents;
- Procedures adopted;
- Methodology;
- Major factors that influence the value of Civil Works/ Plant & Machinery;
- Conversion of all measurements as per SI units;
- Visit report, pictures, dates, persons/officer accompanied;
- Identification of the asset GIS coordinates of premises visited;
- Conclusion;
- Caveats, limitations and disclaimers;

For Civil Works:

- Building wise cost of construction (Total built up area in sq. ft. and cost of construction in Rs. per sq. ft.);
- Comparison of companies' cost of construction with standard CPWD rates, if available.
 Reasons for deviations thereof;
- Total area of the building/civil works with clear demarcation;
- Permitted usage of the building as per the site plan;
- Insured value of building;

- List of all approvals obtained for the land parcel/building (including approved layout by the municipal or such applicable authority, as built drawings);
- Nature of access (private/public, width of access, all weather road) to the site;
- Topography of the land parcel and adjacent area especially any high tension wires crossovers;
- Existing/ongoing development in nearby area;
- It is desirable to have a map of the land parcel and the land parcel must be duly marked on revenue map;
- Ownership of land, type of ownership i.e. freehold or leasehold, tenure of lease, etc.;

For Plant & Machinery:

- Equipment wise break up of installed cost of plant & machinery supported by necessary documents;
- Estimated cost of similar plant & machinery (different make and country of origin, if available);
- Location detail of plant & machinery;
- List of major equipment/machinery along with make & capacity;
- Date of put to use for plant & machinery;
- Whether plant & machinery procured domestically or imported;
- Comment on present condition and obsolescence of plant & machinery;
- Insured value of plant & machinery;
- Documentary proof of installation of plant & machinery at site supported by valid documents;
- Certify the condition of plant & machinery, New or old / refurbished / second hand;
- Confirm the working condition of the machine i.e. working or non-working. Suitability
 of usage for approved product under respective scheme and annual production
 capacity;
- Mention the date from which the plant & machinery has been put in use for commercial operation;

The above is a broad scope of work. The format of the certificate to be submitted by the Chartered Engineer shall be prescribed separately for respective scheme.
