

SC asks ECI to publish names excluded from Kerala draft rolls, consider extending objection deadline

NEW DELHI : The Supreme Court on Thursday directed that the names of persons excluded from the draft electoral rolls in Kerala following the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) be made publicly available both at local offices and

on the Election Commission of India's (ECI) official website. A bench of Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant and Justice Joymalya Bagchi was hearing a clutch of petitions challenging the ongoing SIR process in the state.

During the hearing, the petitioner's side submitted that nearly 24 lakh names had been deleted in the draft rolls released by the poll body and argued that affected individuals could not file objections without a published list of those excluded. "They have to list objections, but the list of those persons deleted is not available. Now people have to go back and file objections stating why you deleted me; that opportunity is missing for us," counsel submitted. It was further contended that in many cases, individuals were wrongly

marked as deceased or shown as residing outside Kerala. Taking note of the submission, the apex court ordered that the names of individuals who have been excluded from the draft electoral list, if not already displayed, shall be displayed at the offices of the gram panchayat or any other public office located in the villages, and the list shall also be published on the website. The CJI-led Bench suggested that the ECI may consider extending the deadline for filing objections to deletions. In an earlier hearing, the Supreme Court permitted petitioners seeking additional time for the SIR process of electoral rolls in Kerala to submit their representations to the ECI and directed the poll body to decide on these by December 31, 2025. According to official figures, Kerala had 2,78,50,856 voters on the rolls before the revision. Of these, 2,54,42,352

Op-Sindoor not yet completely over, fight against terror will continue: Rajnath Singh

JAIPUR : Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on Thursday asserted that Operation Sindoor is not yet over, declaring that India's efforts for peace will continue until the ideology of terrorism is completely eradicated.

Addressing the Shaurya Sandhya (Evening of Valour) programme at the Sai Man Singh (SMS) Stadium on the occasion of Army Day, Rajnath Singh said: "Operation Sindoor is not yet completely over because until the mindset of terrorism is eliminated, our pursuit of peace will not stop. I am making this declaration from the brave land of Rajasthan."

As Army paratroopers descended into the stadium, the venue reverberated with chants of 'Jai Ho', creating a charged patriotic atmosphere in the presence of the Defence Minister. Rajnath Singh said that through Operation Sindoor, India not only demonstrated its military strength but also its national character. "The action against terrorists was taken with careful planning and humanitarian values in mind. That is why Operation Sindoor will be remembered not just as a mil-

Property of Pakistan-based terror handler attached in J&K's Poonch



JAMMU :The property of a Pakistan-based terror handler in J&K's Poonch district has been attached, police said on Thursday.

"In a decisive legal action against terrorism and anti-national elements operating from across the border, Poonch police have attached an immovable property belonging to a Pakistan-based terror handler, in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Court," a police statement said.

The attachment, effected

in connection with FIR No. 07/2002 registered at Police Station Mandi under Sections 2/3 of the E&MCO Act, comprises 10 kanal 14 marlas of land, falling under Khasra Nos 491 situated in Tehsil Mandi, District Poonch, with an assessed value of approximately Rs 22.05 lakh, it said.

According to the police, the attached property belongs to Abdul Aziz, son of Ahmeda Lone, resident of Chamber Kanari, Tehsil Mandi, Poonch, who is

presently operating as a Pakistan-based terror handler.

"The accused had earlier exfiltrated to Pakistan/PoJK and has since been actively involved in activities inimical to the security and sovereignty of the nation. Owing to his continued evasion of the legal process, the accused was declared a Proclaimed Offender by the Hon'ble Court. Despite sustained efforts by Poonch police to secure his arrest, he remained beyond the reach

of law, compelling the Hon'ble Court to order attachment of his immovable property," the statement said.

"Acting upon these directions, the attachment was executed by Poonch Police in close coordination with the Revenue Department, after following all due legal procedures, verification, and documentation."

The police statement said that this action forms part of a broader and sustained strategy to dismantle the financial and logistical support structures of terror networks and to ensure that individuals involved in terrorism and anti-national activities are deprived of their resources.

"District Police Poonch reiterates its unwavering commitment to act firmly and lawfully against Pakistan-based terror handlers and all elements involved in activities prejudicial to national security, and assures the public that such measures will continue in the interest of peace, public safety, and sovereignty of the nation," the statement added.

ED arrests Kerala businessman for duping cashew traders of Rs 24 crore

KOCHI : A businessman who duped Kerala cashew traders of Rs 24 crore with the false promise of procuring low-cost stock from Tanzania was arrested by the ED from the state's Ernakulam, an official statement said on Thursday.

The Directorate of Enforcement's (ED) Kochi Zonal Office, arrested Anesh Babu, 35, a resident of Kollam, on January 14 under Section 19(1) of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002. On Thursday, he was produced before the Special Court (PMLA), Ernakulam, which sent him to judicial custody till January 19. The ED initiated an investigation into the matter based on multiple FIRs registered by Kerala Police and re-registered by the Crime Branch, Kollam, alleging large-scale cheating of cashew traders. It was revealed that Anesh Babu, through his entities, namely Bi Southern .

NITI Aayog unveils blueprint to empower MSMEs by boosting scheme implementation, service delivery

NEW DELHI : NITI Aayog on Thursday released a detailed blueprint to improve outcomes for the micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) by streamlining scheme implementation, strengthening inter-ministerial coordination, and enhancing the delivery of financial, skill, marketing, and innovation support.

The report, titled 'Achieving Efficiencies in MSME Sector through Convergence of Schemes', outlines a strategic roadmap to strengthen the effectiveness of government support for MSMEs in the country.

Among other suggestions, the report proposes an AI-powered centralised digital platform integrating MSME

schemes, compliance, finance, and market intelligence. "Drawing on global best practices, the portal would feature information, process, compliance, and market research modules, supported by AI chatbots, dashboards, and mobile access for real-time support to MSMEs," NITI Aayog said in a statement. Further, the report evaluates existing government schemes and programmes for the MSME sector, assesses the current level of convergence among them, and identifies best practices from central, state, and international experiences, offering actionable recommendations to unlock convergence opportunities and undertake corrective measures to

improve efficiency, outreach, and impact of MSME schemes. There are 18 schemes spanning critical support areas such as credit assistance, skill development, marketing support, innovation and R&D, technology and quality upgradation, and infrastructure development. The report recommends a two-pronged approach to convergence, comprising information convergence and process convergence. "Information convergence focuses on integrating government-generated data at the central and state levels to improve coordination, enable informed decision-making, and strengthen governance outcomes," it highlighted. Two, process conver-

gence aims at aligning and unifying schemes to reduce redundancies, streamline operations, and improve service delivery.

This includes merging similar schemes, combining common components, and fostering collaboration across ministries and states to create a cohesive MSME support ecosystem. The report proposes integration of the Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) with the Micro and Small Enterprises - Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP). Also, the report proposes rationalising of skill initiatives into a three-tier structure covering entrepreneurship and business skills, MSME.

MP Assembly session to commence from Feb 16 to March 6

BHOPAL : The Madhya Pradesh Assembly will convene on February 16, marking the beginning of the ninth session of the 16th Vidhan Sabha. The session will open at 11 a.m. in Bhopal with the Governor's address, setting the stage for what is expected to be the annual Budget, supplementary demands and Legislative activity focusing on development, welfare schemes, and economic reforms. Discussions on the Governor's address and Motion of Thanks are slated for February 17-18, with amendments due by February 16 at 5 p.m. Private member business, including Bills and resolutions, is allocated to Fridays' last 2.5 hours (February 20, February 27 and March 6), with notice deadlines on

February 4-5. Pre-session notices for adjournments, attention calls, and no-confidence motions start on February 10.

The Assembly session will run until March 6, with sittings scheduled from February 16-20, February 23-27, and March 5-6. Daily proceedings will include question hours, government business from Tuesday to Thursday, and private member bills and resolutions on Fridays. Holidays will be observed on weekends and during Holi on March 3, with no sittings on March 2 and 4. The Assembly Secretariat has emphasised adherence to rules of conduct, banning personal allegations and premature publication of notices, while reinforcing security protocols and voting

procedures. Assembly members are urged to update addresses and adhere to notice submission norms for smooth proceedings.

This session, under Chief Minister Mohan Yadav's BJP-led government, is poised for key debates on state issues, aligning with constitutional accountability.

With Madhya Pradesh's diverse tribal and rural demographics, the session is expected to highlight inclusive growth, infrastructure expansion, and agricultural support through schemes like PM-KISAN and Ayushman Bharat. Past Assembly sessions have seen landmark legislation on women's empowerment and digital governance, and this sitting is poised to continue that trajectory.
