Please refer to your above RTI Application seeking information as per the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

At the outset, it is stated that seeking justification and clarification or reasons etc. does not fall within the ambit of Information as per the provisions of Sec 2 (f) of the RTI Act, 2005. Your reference is also invited to the decision of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in the case titled as Dr. Celsa Pinto Vs Goa State Information Commission, wherein the Hon'ble High Court observed as under:-

"The definition cannot include within its fold answers to the question why which would be the same thing as asking the reason for a justification for a particular thing. The Public Information Authorities cannot expect to communicate to the citizen the reason why a certain thing was done or not done in the sense of a justification because the citizen makes a requisition about information. Justifications are matter within the domain of adjudicating authorities and cannot properly be classified as information".
