Therefore, I seek your assistance and request you to kindly provide <u>me the following information under RTI Act:</u>

- (i) Please provide me a certified copy of working sheet/notings showing detailed calculations based on which the ordinary rate of basic family pension of Rs.1748/- p.m. being paid to me w.e.f. 25.04.2014 had been arrived at.
- (ii) Please inform the definition of "pay" as provided in the IFCI Pension Regulations, 1993 for fixation/grant of family pension to the dependents of the deceased employees/pensioners of IFCI.
- (iii) Please provide a certified copy of the relevant Regulation of the IFCI Pension Regulations, 1993 which defines/explains the "pay" for fixation and grant of family pension to the dependents of the deceased employees/pensioners of IFCI Ltd.
- (iv) Please provide a certified copy of the relevant Regulation of the IFCI Pension Regulations, 1993 which specifically authorizes IFCI to fix/grant family pension to the dependents of its deceased employees/pensioners who retired or died on or after 01.11.1997with reference to the "pay"which fell/existed in the pay scaleswhich remained in force from 01.11.1992 to 31.10.1997.
- (v) Please provide a certified copy of the relevant Regulation of the IFCI Pension Regulations, 1993 in terms of which dependents of the employees/pensioners who died or retired on or after 1.11.1997 are granted Dearness Relief at the ratesas are applicable to the pensioners of 1.11.1992 to 31.10.1997 pay scale period.
